

Key Messages

- If you are looking for a primary care provider, you can register yourself, your family and anyone you are caring for on the Health Connect Registry.
 - A person in your care is someone you are caring for and does not live in your household, or live in your household and is not a family member.
- The Health Connect Registry is a tool that helps people find a local family doctor or healthcare provider who can support their ongoing healthcare needs.
- Registration can be done quickly and easily online. Use [this link to get started](#).
 - If you don't have internet access or need translation services (available in over 100 languages), register by calling HealthConnect BC at 811.
 - If you are deaf or hard of hearing, register by calling TIS 111.
- The registry will be used to provide your B.C. address including postal code and your personal health number.
- Once registered, you will remain on the registry until you are matched with a family doctor or nurse practitioner in your primary care network.
- When a provider becomes available, you will be contacted using the contact information you provided in the registry.
