

Key Messages

- The Health Connect Registry is a simple, easy-to-use online form for British Columbia's representatives where primary care network (PCN) have identified. It offers patients the opportunity to register for a regular primary care provider or other family doctor or a nurse practitioner located in their home community.
- The Ministry of Health is taking a phased, multi-step approach to the registry for PCN implementation.
  - A full launch of the Health Connect Registry will ensure that BC's health systems and PCNs can effectively manage patient registration.
  - In the early Health Connect Registry roll-out period, PCNs will have an opportunity to facilitate all members of patients from the registry to be added to the registry.
  - In early 2021, the public will have been the ability to be added to the registry.
  - PCNs will be able to share the list - [Health Connect Registry Implementation](#) - with patients in their communities and patients will be able to register themselves, their family or anyone in their area.
