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Our Projects

Agassiz Community Health Centre

We are a team of committed Family Physicians, Nurse Practitioners and Medical Office Assistants supported by a Community Resource Nurse/Clinic Supervisor, Respiratory Therapist, Dietitian and volunteer who work together to improve the health care of our Agassiz / Harrison Hot Springs community.

Current Services

Our current services include full spectrum Family Medical care, including hospital care for all our patients at Chilliwack General Hospital, with home visits to the frail and elderly, obstetric care in the office and Youth Clinic on Fridays. We provide acute care for all patients in the area from Monday to Friday, and open access services for unattached patients from Tuesday to Thursday 2 to 4 pm. We accept referrals for patients with skin conditions, and chronic pain conditions who are requesting acupuncture from the surrounding area. We also offer acute medical care for Britco employees.

New Physician
