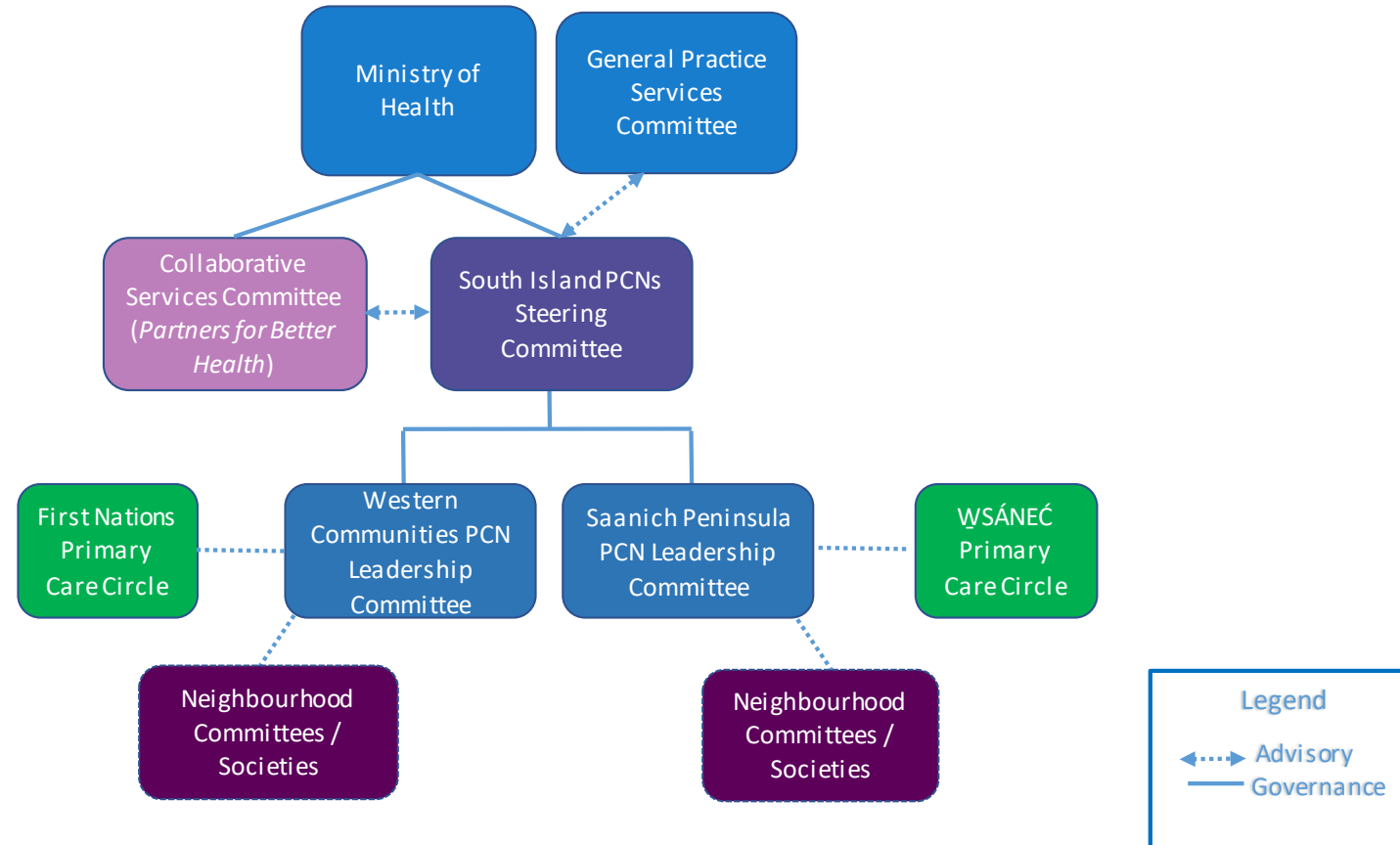
# Local Health Area

# SI PCN Governance Structure

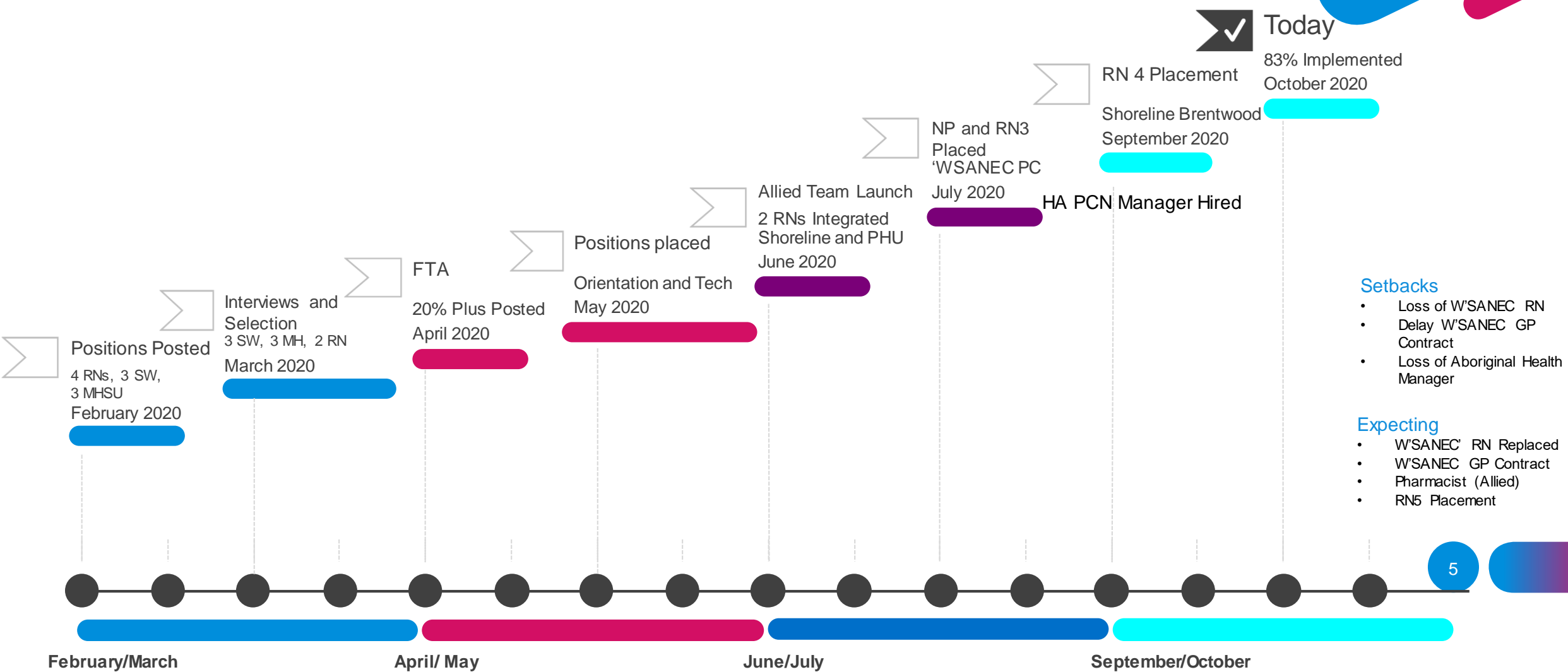


# Implementation

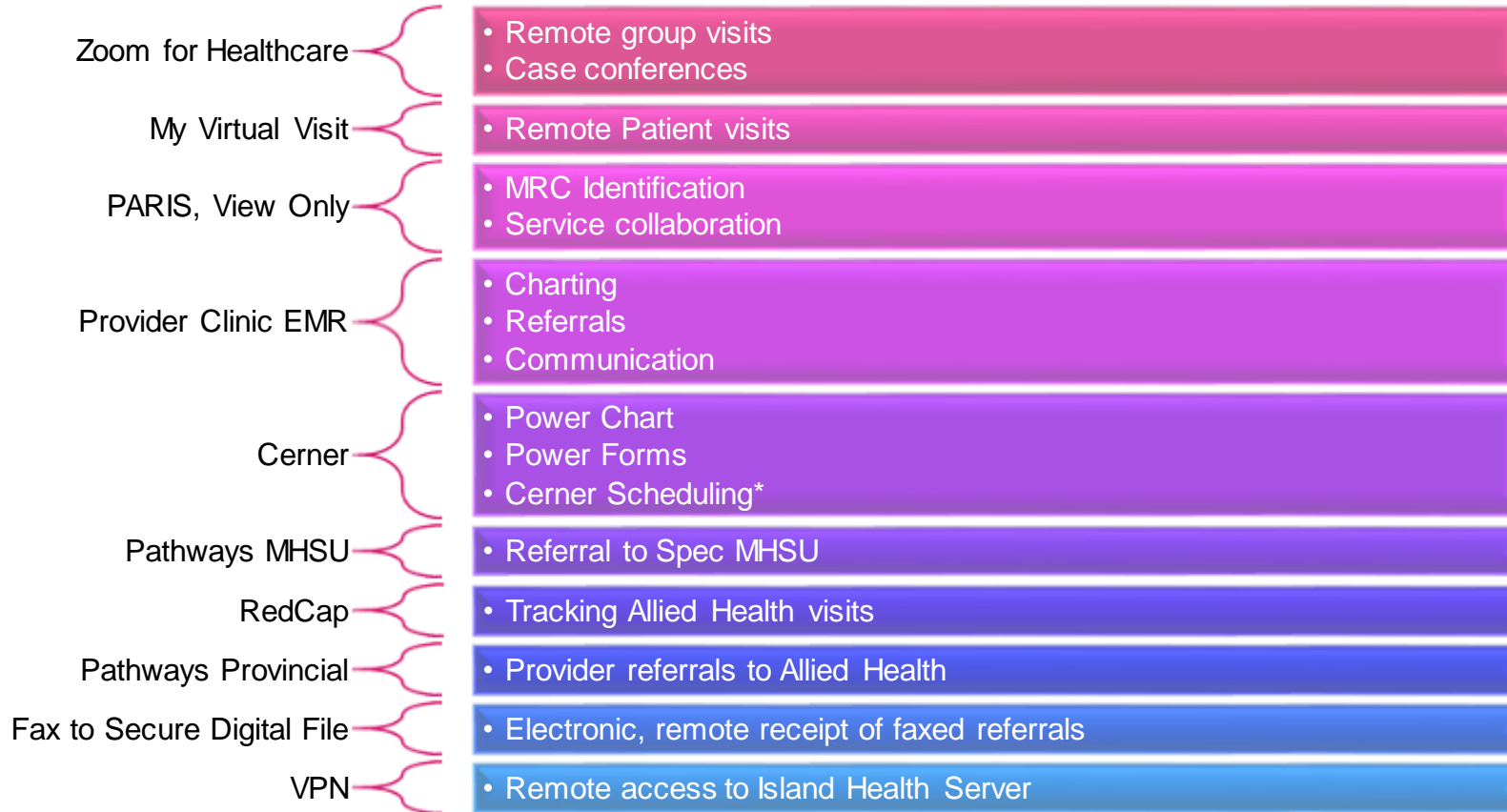

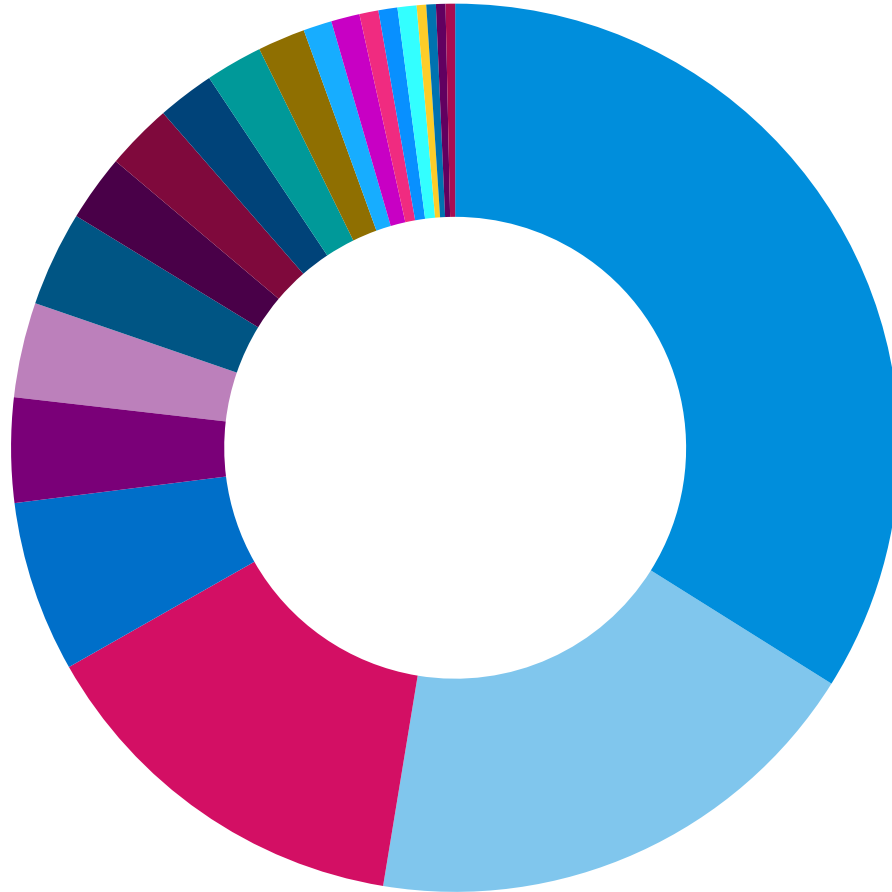
